





1 OLD TOWN HALL

Brno's oldest secular building, centre of city government from the mid-13th century

- * The Old Town Hall has Late Gothic portal with a contorted tower, the work of sculptor Anton Pilgram.
- * In its vaulted passage it shelters two 5 VEGETABLE MARKET symbols of Brno: a stuffed crocodile the so-call "Brno dragon" and a wooden A 13th century square with a market, foun-

- 2 PETROV

The Cathedral of St Peter and St Paul stands atop Petrov Hill and dominates the city's skyline. Its origins reach back to the 1170s, when a Romanesque rotunda was * erected on the site.

- * The Cathedral underwent one Gothic and two Baroque reconstructions; the two characteristic towers are more * recent - the work of August Kirstein during a Neo-Gothic rebuild in 1909.
- * At the foot of Petrov is a park, Denis Gardens, offering a panoramic view of * Labyrinth under the Vegetable Market, Brno and its southern surroundings. In good weather you can see the hills of Pálava in the distance
- * The park also features a colonna Napoleonic Wars.

- 3 ŠPILBERK CASTLE

A sweeping castle complex from the 13th century, rebuilt in the 17th and 18th centuries as a mighty military fortress and subsequently as a prison for the most dangerous criminals and political enemies. Here we can see:

- * Parapets with breath-taking views over Brno, and the castle, housing the Brno City Museum and also staging a variety of concerts, theatrical performances and festivals.
- * Castle chimes a 15-bell carillon; also, 7 BRNO UNDERGROUND a lookout in the corner tower, and the Baroque Holy Trinity Chapel

- 4 BRNO'S STATUES

The centre of Brno is dotted with many statues, the most famous being the clock on Freedom Square and the statue Courage on Moravian Square.

* The time machine or town clock made of black granite was installed in 2010 G Temple of Stone - Lapidarium in by sculptor Oldřich Ruibr and student Petr Kameník, Its nearly 6-metre shape → Špilberk 1, www.spilberk.cz is intended to evoke a bullet, and so

commemorate the heroic defence of the city against the Swedish army during the Thirty Years' War.

The statue Courage was installed in 2015 by sculptor Jaroslav Róna. This 8-metre bronze statue portrays a knight on an unusually long-legged horse, and is an allegory of courage.



- * The house was designed by Ludwig Mies van der Rohe for Greta and Fritz
- Formal architectural purity framed in a natural setting, mutually permeating spaces, technical and structural solutions and the use of precious raw materials
- * Other important Brno villas include the Art Nouveau Löw-Beer Villa (Drobného 22), the Art Nouveau Jurkovič House (Jana Nečase 2) and the Functionalist Stiassni Villa (Hroznová 14).
